

# Provision of level 3 qualifications in English schools 2008-2012

Statistics Report Series No.58

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August 2013

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#### Introduction

The purpose of this report is to investigate changes over time in the provision of different level 3 qualifications in English schools. This should give an overall picture, rather than focusing on one or two qualifications (e.g. A levels).

Provision of a subject is usually defined as the percentage of schools (where the qualification is offered in any subject) with at least one student taking a particular subject (e.g. the percentage of schools where A levels are taken that offer A level English). However, as this report looks at multiple qualifications this definition has changed to be the percentage of all schools in England (offering level 3 qualifications) with at least one student taking a particular qualification (or a particular subject in that qualification).

#### Data

The data for these analyses were taken from the National Pupil Database (NPD). This is a database held by the Department for Education, consisting of results for all students in all qualifications and subjects in schools and colleges in England. The Key Stage 5 (KS5) extract of the NPD was used, consisting of all students who were at the end of KS5 (i.e. in year 13).

One of the main purposes of this report was to look at changes to patterns of provision over time, so three separate years were chosen to be analysed: 2007/08, 2009/10 and 2011/12. It is also of interest to investigate patterns of provision in different types of school, so most of the analyses were broken down into the following school types: comprehensive, academy, FE/tertiary college, grammar, independent, secondary modern and sixth form college. Table 1 presents the number of each school type in each year.

It should be noted that over the period investigated a large number of schools (mainly comprehensives) converted to become city academies. This explains the large increase in the number of academies and the decrease in the number of comprehensives and grammar schools (particularly between 2009/10 and 2011/12).

There were a large number of different qualifications recorded in the KS5 extract of the NPD in all three years, but not all of these were included in this report. To make the analyses more manageable only KS5 qualifications that are worth at least the same as an A level were included. Table 2 lists the qualifications and in which years they were available. Thus,

apart from the Diploma and the Pre-U (which were not available in 2007/08) all these qualifications were available in all three years.

Only students in year 13 in the three years considered in this report were included, but any level 3 qualifications that these students took in previous years were counted.

#### Results

### Overall provision of qualifications

Tables 3 to 5 present the number and percentage of schools offering the different qualifications in each year.

In each year almost all schools offered A levels. The percentage offering BTECs increased from 36.8% in 2007/08 to 55.4% in 2011/12. The percentage offering OCR Nationals also increased significantly, from 3.4% to 22.2%. There were falls in the percentage offering applied A levels (from 58.4% to 48.2%) and applied AS levels (from 31.2% to 18.5%).

Tables 6 to 8 break down the provision of qualifications by school type.

In each year the percentage of schools offering A levels was very close to 100% in each school type, except for FE/tertiary colleges. BTECs, OCR Nationals and applied AS levels were most likely to be offered by sixth form colleges. FE/tertiary colleges were more likely than other school types to offer VRQs. Only a small percentage of independent schools offered any alternatives to A levels.

The increase in schools offering the BTEC was across all school types, except for academies and FE/tertiary colleges. All school types saw increases in the percentages offering OCR Nationals although the increases were very small in grammar and independent schools. The largest falls in those offering applied A levels and applied AS levels were in comprehensives, FE/tertiary colleges and secondary modern schools.

## Combinations of qualifications offered by schools

Tables 9 to 11 present the numbers and percentages of schools offering the top 10 combinations of qualifications, sorted by popularity. Appendix A presents the top 5 combinations in each of the different school types.

In each year schools were most likely to offer A levels only. However, the percentage of schools doing so fell from 31% in 2007/08 to 26.9% in 2011/12. The percentage of schools

offering a combination of A levels and Applied A levels (with no other qualifications) decreased from 14.2% to 4.5%. Instead, schools were more likely to offer combinations involving A levels and BTECs (often with other qualifications).

#### Provision of individual subjects

This section presents the provision of the five most popular subjects at level 3<sup>2</sup> – mathematics, biology, psychology, history and English literature.

In 2007/08 the individual subjects taken by IB students were not recorded in the NPD, although each student taking the overall baccalaureate was recorded. This was also before the Pre-U qualification was available, so for the popular subjects there were no recorded alternatives to A levels. Therefore provision is not reported for 2007/08.

#### **Mathematics**

Table 12 and 13 present the provision of different mathematics qualifications.

Only a small percentage of schools offered alternatives to A levels in mathematics, although the percentage offering the IB increased from 3.2% to 3.6% between 2009/10 and 2011/12. Only 11 schools offered the Pre-U subject.

Tables 14 and 15 break down the provision by different school types. Sixth form colleges, grammar and independent schools were the most likely to offer the IB.

## Biology

Tables 16 and 17 present the provision of different biology qualifications. No schools offered the Pre-U in 2009/10. The percentage offering the IB increased from 3.8% in 2009/10 to 4.6% in 2011/12.

Provision of IB (as a percentage of all schools) was again highest in sixth form colleges (7.14% in 2009/10 and 11.81% in 2011/12). Provision in independent schools was relatively low (less than 2%), although so was provision of A level in these schools.

## English Literature

For the IB qualification there was no direct equivalent for English literature (because it is an international qualification, which can be studied in different languages). The nearest equivalent found in the NPD was 'Un-translated literature'; however, entries for this were found only in the 2011/12. Table 28 presents the provision of different English literature qualifications in 2011/12.

A relatively high percentage of schools offered an IB certificate in English literature (4.6%). Again, sixth form colleges were most likely to offer it (17.36% did so).

## Provision of individual subjects in other level 3 qualifications

Finally the provision of the most common subjects offered in other popular qualifications (BTECs and applied A levels) is summarised below. These are worth reporting as a substantial percentage of schools offered these qualifications (see Tables 3 to 5).
