- Battle of Naseby June 1645, Royalists led by Prince Rupert,
   Parliamentarians led by Sir Thomas Fairfax, Parliamentarian victory
- Trial of Charles I opened on 20th January 1649, finished on 27<sup>th</sup>
  January, trial held at Westminster, President Bradshaw wore a bullet
  proof hat, King refused to answer questions.
