The attack on knowledge

Professor Michael Young, Institute of Education, University of London

Professor Young shares his research and revives the debate on 'powerful knowledge' as a means of rejuvenating curriculum thinking in England.

He will sharpen the issues in this debate and will guide us through an area fraught with political and educational controversy, arguing trenchantly for powerful knowledge as an entitlement of all children regardless of their background, motivation or experience.

Assessment of practical work in A Level and GCSE sciences – time to try harder

Professor John Holman, University of York

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Practical work is the essence of science, and learning science without doing experiments is like studying literature without reading books.

Does practical work become distorted when it contributes to final grades? What approaches to coursework will meet criteria for both 'good learning' and 'good assessment'?

Professor Holman will scrutinise models currently used to assess practical skills in schools and will discuss the impact that teachers' tendency to skew marks towards the top of the range has had on the assessment of practical skills in A Level and GCSE sciences.

CASE STUDY

Oman Ministry of Education

Context

The Directorate of Educational Evaluation at the Oman Ministry of Education is responsible for the preparation, marking and analysis of certificated examinations and achievement tests across all 11 regions of the Sultanate of Oman. It sets criteria for exam specifications and various assessment tools related to student performance.

Objective

Equip a select group of item writers and examiners of science and maths with a knowledge of the principles of high stakes assessment and the practical skills for effective question writing.

Challenge

Devise a hands-on training programme that would bring the Ministry item writers and examiners up to speed with best practice in constructing and evaluating test items at a variety of levels.

Benefits for participants

- + Understanding of the key principles underpinning the production of question papers and exam specifications
- + Increased confidence in their ability to produce valid exams that include items at various levels

Solution

A bespoke two-week course in Cambridge comprising lectures, discussions and practical workshops with specialists in maths, biology, chemistry and physics.

The course focused on writing and marking questions in the context of the Omani education system, and was centred around intensive, small group practice with subject specialists.

Delegates said the exchange of ideas with experts in Cambridge was particularly useful, encouraging them to reflect on their own practice and consider the application of different approaches.
